

Structuring Tickets

If you're going to play vertical exotics (bets within a single race such as trifectas and superfectas), you can't simply play everyone with everyone or you'll soon be out of money. You have to have some opinion—then structure your play to reflect that opinion.

Should you play a particular vertical exotic? Among the questions to ask:

- o Do the favorites look obvious (if so, maybe skip this one)?
- o Is there one horse you can key to win, or maybe run second?
- o Is there at least one longshot who can get into the picture?
- o Are there some horses you can throw out altogether?
- o How much do you need to invest to have a reasonable shot?
- o What are the chances the ticket will pay well?
- o Will the probable pace help or hurt some entrants?

These factors will vary from event to event. Trifectas aren't difficult to hit, particularly if you use many combinations. But hitting one for big money isn't easy. And if the favorite runs third, your payoff is likely to be underlaid.

Superfectas often cost only a dime, so you can go deep and wide to find the wacky ones that can pay big. The problem is that you may be tempted to use so many combinations that you can hit the thing and still lose money.

My favorite vertical bet is—if there's a carryover--the super high 5, also known as the pentafecta or the exact 5. Unlike the trifecta, a favorite won't ruin your payoff. Unlike the superfecta, there's a minimum of either 50 cents or \$1, which prevents players from using everyone. And unlike both of them, a carryover means extra money to be won.

I wrote about this bet in the January 2014 issue, but this month I want to emphasize a different aspect of it—the fact that you can key horses who are not the best horses to run in the top five, simply because of the way the race shapes up. This gives

you the chance to hit a home run payoff, because you're not keying 4-5 shots. And, unlike horizontal bets such as the pick 6, you don't have to bet a huge amount to have a chance at a good score (my average lifetime investment in the super high five is \$468, far below what I typically played in the pick 6).

Since I retired in 2011, I don't play the races much. For more than 20 years, I watched nearly every California race live, bet many of them, and studied all the replays, making notes on each horse whenever he raced. I gave an individual rating to every horse, adjusted after each performance. No more. Every so often I get an e-mail notification from Calracing.com about a local carryover, or I check the carryover list at www.rgs.net. I'll then download the Daily Racing Form pp's for that race. If the super high 5 looks promising, I'll buy a one-day subscription to the workout notes at Nationalturf.com (since many of these races are for maidens or maiden claimers). Every so often I'll watch a replay of some particular horse's most recent effort or two.

Understand that I have no handicapping edge in these races. I don't know the horses. I grasp none of the subtleties that made gambling so successful for me during my working days, and no longer have any special insights. These days, on the rare days when I do handicap, I do it right off the Form, just like the typical player does.

The ninth race at Los Alamitos on Dec. 7 is a good example of the type of race I look for. There was a \$19,972 carryover. The field consisted of only eight horses (after #2 was scratched), which made the super high 5 play manageable. Most importantly, it looked as if most of the entrants were what I call pace prisoners—they are stuck on a certain racing style which they exhibit just about every time out, making it possible to predict the pace scenario. And the two horses I keyed were neither the first nor second morning-line choice in the race. Briefly:

- #1 Norastone—front-runner (led at the first call in her last 3 races)
- #3 She's Flush—closer
- #4 Nothing To Hide—closer
- #5 Copper City—front-runner (led at the first call in 4 of her last 5 races)
- #6 Best In Class—front-runner (led at the first call in her last 2 races)
- #7 Runningwiththelute—front-runner (led at the first call in 6 of her last 7 races)
- #8 Cin City Lady—? (maybe stalker or closer)
- #9 Marla Hooch—front-runner (led or within a neck of the lead in 4 of her last 6 starts)

It looked as though there would be a cavalry charge into the turn. Who would

emerge in front? I had no idea. But I did feel that She's Flush and Nothing To Hide—certainly not the fastest horses in the field—would be minding their own business near the rail behind the dueling leaders, and would plod past tired puppies when the leaders stopped. My main decision was that at least one of them would have to finish in the top two, and both of them would have to finish in the top four.

Who could I throw out? Nobody. Everybody had some favorable angles. I did figure that Marla Hooch, from her outside post, would probably be forced wide and was thus least likely to finish up close, so I used her only in slots 3 through 5. All the rest of the horses I used in every slot.

Note that this was a \$1 minimum bet (the Form's listing was incorrect). I invested \$1,040, figuring that no matter who came in where, the payoff was going to be decent—though Nothing To Hide wound up going off the mild 3-1 favorite, She's Flush was let away at 8-1, and nobody in the race reached double-figure odds. The tickets are displayed on the page (don't you just hate it when somebody claims to bet but you never see their tickets?).

Not surprisingly, the whole world went for the lead except our two gals and Cin City Lady. Marla Hooch was forced wide and disappeared. When the dust cleared, our two plodders did their thing. She's Flush rallied to win, while Nothing To Hide finished behind an onrushing Cin City Lady in fourth. The payoff was \$8,057 (\$2,014 of which was withheld until tax time).

It was the only bet I made at Los Alamitos all year.

Footnotes

SHE'S FLUSH chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. RUNNINGWITHTHELUTE stalked outside then three deep into and on the turn, bid three wide into the stretch, gained the lead in the drive, inched away and held well but was caught late. CIN CITY LADY settled off the rail then angled in nearing the turn, came out in the stretch and got up three wide late for the show. NOTHING TO HIDE stalked between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch, angled in again and was edged for third between foes. NORASTONE saved ground stalking the pace, got through inside in the stretch and also was edged for third. BEST IN CLASS dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, was between foes into the stretch and weakened. MARLA HOOCH stalked outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. COPPER CITY had speed between horses then dueled a bit off the rail, battled along the fence on the turn and into the stretch and had little left for the stretch.
